### From the Pastor

#### Come and See!

Think about the best invitation you had ever received. Who made the invitation? Where were you invited? How was the event?

In the first chapter of John, Jesus makes an invitation to the first disciples. The invitation is short and simple and yet powerful and life changing. He said to them, "Come and See."

When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" (which translated means Teacher), "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day." (John 1.38)

This invitation is not limited to those who Jesus encountered 2000 years ago. This is an invitation for you and to me. We are invited to come and see, again and again. When we come and see, we are reminded of the life changing gift that Jesus is for each of us. When we come and see, we experience Jesus and his love.

The focus of the church is ministry – making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. In our baptismal vows, we covenant to faithfully participate in the ministries of the Church by our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service and our witness. Will you invite AT LEAST one person this year to come and see? By making this invitation, you are providing the opportunity for your friend or family member to experience God's love and its transformative power. So, who will it be? Remember most people need to be invited 3 or more times before they accept the invitation. Don't give up!

Issuing the invitation is the first step but it doesn't end there. We need to provide a space filled with gracious hospitality. It is one of our most important commitments – welcoming and accepting the people who God places in our lives. It is so simple, but we often look past it. We are invited to be in relationship with others, giving them the gift of our time and presence.

My hope is that our congregation can be the face of God to one another and our community. May we continue to build relationships, grow in faith and affirm of belovedness of our neighbors. May we commit to do this together, as we live into the gift of God's abundant grace.


